Finance and Car Park Committee Meeting.

Minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday, 20th August 2014
In Port Isaac School (Library)
The meeting opened at 6.30pm.

1. Housekeeping: Cllr. Coles reminded those present of Emergency Procedures, Location of WCs and that there were no local hazards.
2. Apologies for Absence: None.
3. Declarations of Interest: None.
4. Public Forum: None present.
5. Matters Arising from the previous Meeting: None, all Matters contained within the Agenda.
6. Income, Car Park Management: The level of income from The Main car park remained constant, with payments being made into the bank at regular intervals by AS Parking. It was however, discussed that the need for an overflow car park was apparent to accommodate the high numbers of visitors to Port Isaac, as the present car park capacity was proving to be insufficient on most days at the height of the holiday season. Suggest this be discussed further by full Council.
It was agreed that signs reading 'No Parking on the Grass' be installed. Clerk to order 4 signs, black on white.
Several quotes for a barrier across the dropped kerb were considered. Barriers Direct was chosen as the most suitable on price and quality. Clerk to place order.
It was agreed that a further contract be entered into with Cale Briparc to cover insurance and maintenance of car park machines over the coming year. Clerk to contact.
7. Cllr. Raynor reported that some 22,090 persons had been recorded using the Roscarrock Hill toilets in the period 31.7.14 to 19.8.14.
8. Although it was agreed that this Council should not concern itself with the re-location of the bulk waste bins, alongside New Road toilets, it was felt that it must insist that Cornwall Council fit lockable lids to each bin to prevent unauthorised use of these bins and to render the bins safe and hygienic should they remain in their present location.
9. Items for next agenda: Additional double yellow lines in Trewetha and Port Isaac, quote for repairs to bus shelter, and to receive a report from The Firework Committee.
