PM03/2015	<u>Reports from other organisations</u> – a. <i>Police</i> – a police report was read to the meeting, copy on file. He urged everyone to report a crime and apologised for the delay problems with the 101 call number. PC Malcolm Taylor had retired and had not been replaced. There is a problem locally with a mentally ill resident. PCSO Drennan sent her apologies, due to family illness. Cllr.
