Grave tablet		30" x 15" Flat with the grass-not proud
Children's memorial		Max 36" high, with a flat back, max 4" deep, max 30" wide
Desks, wedges and books		Freestanding, not to exceed 15" high and 30" wide
Cremation tablet		15" x 9" Flat with the grass-not proud
Headstone top shape		Ogee, half ogee, oval, square , peon and half peon
Headstone dimensions		Max 36" H x 4" D x 30"W
Headstone material		Natural rock- slate, granite or marble
Headstone colour		The natural colours of slate, granite or marble
Headstone finish		Polished, part polished or honed
Lettering font		Material appropriate
Lettering colour		Black, white, grey, silver, gold
Flowers		Natural only
Artificial flowers		No
Other items e.g. flags, windmills, models		No
Planted flowers or shrubs		No
Artificial wreaths		No, with the exception of Christmas wreaths
Memorial statuettes		No
Bronze ornamentation		No
Photos of deceased on headstone or tablet		Subject to approval of the full Council
Inscription		"Simple and reverent" and subject to approval of the full Council
Number of non-glass removable vases		Maximum of 3
Solar lighting		No
Cremation plot gravel		No

The Council reserves the right to refuse the installation or exclude or remove from the cemetery any memorial not executed in a workmanlike manner or from unsound materials or which in the opinion of the Council disfigures the cemetery or offends public decency. The decision is final.

Scale of Fees and Charges.

St Endellion Cemetery Fees

Single	£200
Double	£265
Cremation	£65
Stone erection	£90

Fee for anyone who has lived outside of the Parish for more than 10 years:

Single	£600
Double	£795
Cremation	£195
Stone erection	£270

There will be no charges for single occupancy for children under 12 years of age from the Parish or adjoining Parishes.

**NOTE – plots are allocated in rotation even when purchased in advance,
i.e. it is not permitted to select the location of a plot.**
